Unit Overview

In this unit, the children will learn that God created the land, water, trees and all plant life. They will learn about the properties and uses of land and water, and will also learn about the components of trees, flowers and fruits.

Unit Goals

- The children will identify land, water, plants and trees.
- The children will learn that God created these things to make them happy and to take care of them.
- The children will learn to thank God for what he has created.

Dear Parent,

On the reverse side of this page, you will find an outline and description of the lessons which comprise this unit. Included is a Bible Truth for you to review with your child at home. Please note that this is simply a biblical concept and not an actual verse.

Your active involvement outside the classroom is essential and will truly make the Kingdom Kids Curriculum a great success for your child. Here are some suggested ways you can reinforce these lessons at home:

- Bringing a spoon, a bag and a magnifying glass, take an "earth walk" with your child. Help find rocks to examine. Use the magnifying glass to help your child look at the rocks more closely. Point out how hard the rocks are and that God made them. Have your child dig in the dirt and play with it.
- Bathtime takes on a new meaning as your child learns that God made water to be useful and fun! Allow your child to give a bath to a doll or a tub toy.
- Help your child to find a wildflower or any interesting, non-poisonous plant, and loosen the soil around it. Gently pull up the plant together. Point out the flower, the leaves, the stem, and the roots to your child. Explain that God made the beautiful flower or plant grow out of the soil. Be sure to replant the flower or plant when you are finished.
