

Kingdom Kids Curriculum – Quarter 1 2 and 3 Year Olds Materials List

U1 L1 Core

For each child:

- 1 piece each of black, white and yellow construction paper
- 1 star sticker
- 1 white paper plate
- 5 star stickers
- · dry washcloth or baby wipe
- glue stick
- small paper cup
- small portion of dry cereal

For the teacher:

- 6 large craft sticks
- 6 small paper plates
- · age appropriate Bible story
- Bible
- construction paper or poster board for a sun and moon or star
- construction paper: 1 sheet each of blue, white and yellow; 2 sheets of black
- · extra star stickers
- glue or stapler
- hand mirror
- scissors
- · thin black marker

U1 L1 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 lightweight, plastic flashlight with working batteries
- 1 star sticker
- · 6 gold star stickers
- craft stick
- · glue stick
- white, black and yellow construction paper

For the teacher:

- · 6 large craft sticks
- · 6 small paper plates
- · a dark colored sheet or blanket
- Bible
- construction paper: 1 sheet each of blue, white, yellow and 2 sheets of black
- · extra star stickers
- · glue or stapler
- scissors
- table or chairs to put the sheet over
- · thin black marker

U1 L2 Core

For each child:

- 1 piece of blue construction paper
- · cotton balls
- · glue stick

For the teacher:

- 1 sheet blue construction paper for sky
- 1 sheet of black poster board
- 1 sheet of light blue poster board or craft paper
- · 4 sheets of white poster board

- 4 sheets white construction paper for clouds
- Rible
- black marker
- cotton (optional)
- glue stick (optional)
- scissors

U1 L2 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 handle for the sponge (handles can be made from spools, empty glue stick lids, wood blocks, etc.)
- 1 lightweight, plastic flashlight with working batteries
- 1 sheet of blue construction paper
- 1 thin sponge
- smock, old T-Shirt or apron for protection

For the teacher:

- 1 sheet blue construction paper for sky
- 3 plastic plates or aluminum pie tins
- 4 sheets white construction paper for clouds
- · a dark colored sheet or blanket
- Bible
- black marker
- cardboard
- extra sheets of construction paper
- glue
- scissors
- · table or chairs to put the sheet over
- · white water-based paint

U1 L3 Core

For each child:

- 1 orange, yellow or gold paper plate,
 6" diameter
- · construction paper; yellow, orange
- · glue stick
- · yarn or ribbon, 20"

For the teacher:

- 16 unlined index cards, 3" x 5" (or cards of that size made from poster board)
- Bible
- black permanent marker
- · black, yellow and white felt
- flannel board with light blue background
- glitter (optional)
- · laminate or clear contact paper
- markers
- scissors
- · single hole punch
- tape
- · two-sided tape

U1 L3 Supplement

For each child:

- · 1 sheet yellow construction paper
- 1/8 sheet yellow tissue paper
- · dry washcloth or baby wipe

- alue stick
- small paper cup
- small portion of dry cereal
- white or light blue construction paper

For the teacher.

- Bible
- black marker
- construction paper or poster board for a sun and moon or star
- black, yellow and white felt
- Flannel board with light blue background
- glitter (optional)
- hand mirror

- tape

U1 L4 Core

For each child:

- 1 address label sticker
- 4 or 5 star stickers
- black construction paper
- contact paper
- · empty toilet paper tube
- varn

For the teacher:

- Rible

- glitter (optional)
- hole punch
- scissors
- tono
- toothpicks

U1 L4 Supplement

- For each child:1 sheet each yellow and white construction paper
- construction pape
- 4 or 5 cotton balls
- blue crayonsglue stick

For the teacher:

- 1 sheet of black poster board
- 1 sheet of light blue poster board or craft paper
- 4 sheets of white poster board
- Bible

U2 L1 Core

For each child:

- 1 sheet of construction paper, white or light blue
- 1 small rock (large enough to pass the safety cylinder test and with no sharp edges)

- 1 strip of white paper
- · alue stick
- medicine dropper
- smock, old T-shirt, or apron for protection
- white coffee filter

For the teacher:

- 2 containers to hold paint
- a towel or an inverted tablecloth with felt backing
- Bible
- blue and green tempera paint, craft paint or food coloring
- extra towels for drying
- glue
- hand towel
- marker
- newspapers
- plastic dishes
- plastic sheet, shower curtain liner or tablecloth
- · sand to fill box lid halfway
- · small bowl
- · small tub or dishpan
- sturdy cardboard box lid, or a 9" x 13" pan
- · washable baby doll
- washcloth
- water to fill bowl halfway
- water to fill tub 1/3 full

U2 L1 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 small rock (large enough to pass the safety cylinder test and with no sharp edges)
- 2 sheets of contrasting colored paper, cloth or wallpaper
- cotton swab (optional)
- · glue stick
- green or blue sheet of construction paper
- smock, old T-shirt or apron for protection
- · strip of paper for Bible Truth
- white tempera or children's paint.

For the teacher:

- 2 containers (to hold paint)
- 2 plastic sheets, shower curtain liners or tablecloths
- · 2 rulers or paint sticks
- 2 small paint brushes
- 2 small tubs or dishpans
- 2 towels or inverted tablecloths with felt backing
- Bible
- extra towels for drying
- floating items: plastic spoon, a lightweight plastic dish, a lightweight plastic toy, etc.
- marker
- newspaper or protective covering
- plate (optional)
- play items: a plastic watering can, a few Styrofoam cups for straining, a turkey baster, a medicine dropper, a sponge, etc.
- sand to fill box lid half way

- scissors
- sinking items: metal spoon, a rock, a small tov car, etc.
- small bowl
- sturdy cardboard box lid or a 9" x 13" pan
- water to fill bowl half way
- · water to fill tubs 1/3 full
- white glue (optional)

U2L2 Core

For each child:

- 1 small rock (I large enough to pass the safety cylinder test and with no sharp edges)
- craft glue
- · glue stick
- smock, old T-shirt, or apron for protection

For the teacher:

- 1/2 sheet white construction paper, 9" x 6"
- a towel or an inverted tablecloth with felt backing
- Bible
- blue plastic wrap or clear plastic wrap with blue construction paper
- · extra towels for drying
- hand towel
- marker
- plastic dishes
- plastic sheet, shower curtain liner or tablecloth
- · sand to fill box lid halfway
- sandpaper, 2" x 9" strips
- scissors
- small bowl
- small tub or dishpan
- sturdy cardboard box lid, or a 9" x 13" pan
- · washable baby doll
- washcloth
- water to fill bowl halfway
- water to fill tub 1/3 full

U2 L2 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 orange sheet of construction paper
- 1 small rock (large enough to pass the safety cylinder test and with no sharp edges)
- crayons
- · alue stick
- smock, old T-shirt or apron for protection

For the teacher:

- 2 plastic sheets, shower curtain liners or tablecloths
- 2 small tubs or dishpans
- 2 towels or inverted tablecloths with felt backing
- Bible
- colored construction paper (green, yellow, brown, blue and white)
- extra towels for drying
- floating items: plastic spoon, a lightweight plastic dish, a lightweight plastic toy, etc.

- marker
- play items: a plastic watering can, a few Styrofoam cups for straining, a turkey baster, a medicine dropper, a sponge, etc.
- sand to fill box lid halfway
- scissors
- sinking items: metal spoon, a rock, a small toy car, etc.
- small bowl
- sturdy cardboard box lid, or a 9" x 13"
- water to fill bowl halfway
- water to fill tubs 1/3 full

U2 L3 Core

For each child:

- 1 sheet of light colored construction paper
- glue stick
- tissue paper in two different colors

For the teacher:

- 4 unlined index cards, 3" x 5"
- Bible
- bowl
- box lid
- construction paper
- green marker
- laminate or clear contact paper
- · markers or crayons
- sand
- scissors
- small green non-poisonous leaves from a tree or houseplant
- spray bottle of perfume or cologne
- water to fill bowl 1/3 full

U2 L3 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 white paper plate
- glue stick

For the teacher:

- Bible
- bowl
- box lid
- flannel boar
- magazine
- marker
- pellon (a thin stiff white fabric found in craft and fabric stores) or white felt or colored felt
- san
- scissors
- small green non-poisonous leaves from a tree or houseplant
- water to fill bowl 1/3 full

U2 L4 Core

For each child:

- 1 paper napkin
- black crayon
- glue stick
- red, green, black and white construction paper

For the teacher:

 1 piece of red, green and yellow construction paper or the colors of the fruits used

- 1 sheet of poster board
- 3 apples: 1 red, 1 green and 1 yellow (or 3 unique pieces of fruit)
- 3 plates
- apple slicer
- Bible
- black marker
- howl
- box lid
- glue stick
- marker
- sand
- scissors
- small green non-poisonous leaves from a tree or houseplant
- water to fill bowl 1/3 full

U2 L4 Supplement For each child:

- 1 piece of white or light blue construction paper
- · alue stick
- smocks or old T-shirts or aprons for protection

For the teacher:

- Bible
- howl
- box lid
- brown paper bags or brown packing paper
- different paint colors for seasonal tree leaves: green, yellow, orange, red and brown
- · flannel board
- marker
- · new sponges
- newspapers
- · paper towels
- plastic or Styrofoam containers for paint
- sand
- scissors
- small bowl of water 1/3 full
- small green non-poisonous leaves from a tree or houseplant
- water to fill bowl 1/3 full
- · wet wipes or wet paper towels

U3 L1 Core

For each child:

- 1 small sprig of greenery, live or plastic
- · 2 paper plates
- · 6 fish crackers
- · blue plastic wrap
- · glue stick

For the teacher:

- 1 plastic tablecloth or sheet of plastic to put the sand tub on
- 1 round shallow tub for sand (size of a plastic dishpan)
- 1 sheet of blue construction paper
- 1 sheet of laminate or clear contact paper
- · 1 small bag of sand
- 1 small plastic bucket and shovel
- 4 unlined index cards, 3" x 5"

- 6 sea shells (large enough to pass the safety cylinder test and with no sharp edges)
- bright colored markers
- alue stick
- laminate or clear contact paper
- markers
- scissors
- stapler or tape
- tape (optional)

U3 L1 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 white paper plate
- alue stick

For the teacher:

- 1 bucket or small trash can
- 1 plastic tablecloth or sheet of plastic to put the sand tub on
- 1 round shallow tub for sand (size of a plastic dishpan)
- 1 sheet of black construction paper
- 1 sheet of blue construction paper
- 1 sheet of laminate or clear contact paper
- 1 small bag of sand
- 1 small plastic bucket and shovel
- 1 stick, 2' long (or a wooden dowel or thin plastic pole)
- 12 paper clips
- 6 pieces of different colored construction paper or poster board or wallpaper samples or felt
- 6 sea shells (large enough to pass the safety cylinder test and with no sharp edges)
- black marker
- · hot glue gun
- laminate or clear contact paper
- magnet (use a refrigerator magnet temporarily)
- scissors
- several sheets of brightly colored tissue paper
- string
- · tape

U3 L2 Core

For each child:

- 1 cardboard toilet tissue tube
- · 9 small circular reinforcement stickers
- glue stick

For the teacher:

- 1 plastic tablecloth or sheet of plastic to put the sand tub on
- 1 round shallow tub for sand (size of a plastic dishpan)
- 1 small bag of sand
- 1 small plastic bucket and shovel
- 6 sea shells (large enough to pass the safety cylinder test and with no sharp edges)
- blue tissue paper
- scissors

U3 L2 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 sheet of blue or green construction paper
- aluestick

For the teacher:

- 1 bucket or small trash can
- 1 plastic tablecloth or sheet of plastic to put the sand tub on
- 1 round shallow tub for sand (size of a plastic dishpan)
- 1 sheet of black construction
- 1 small bag of sand
- 1 small plastic bucket and shovel
- 12 paper clips
- 6 sea shells (large enough to pass the safety cylinder test and with no sharp edges)
- blue and green crayons (optional)
- large natural sponge or kitchen sponge
- sandpaper
- scraps of cloth or wallpaper

U3 L3 Core

For each child:

- 1 sheet of construction paper
- 2 gummy worms or small pieces of bread
- smock, old T-shirt or apron

For the teacher:

- 3 different colors of tempera paint
- 3 shallow plastic bowls or aluminum pie tins to put the paint in
- 5 craft sticks`
- 9 craft feathers
- black marker
- glue
- laminate or clear contact paper
- markers
- newspapers
- sheet or thin blanket

For each child:
