Creation 1

Unit Overview

Two and three year olds are incredibly observant. They often notice the simple joys of God's creation that adults take for granted. In this unit the children will learn that it is God who created all things. The unit will specifically focus on the following aspects of God's creation: day, night, clouds, sky, sun, moon and stars.

Unit Goals

- The children will identify day, night, clouds, sky, sun, moon and stars.
- The children will learn that God created these things to make them happy and to take care of them.
- The children will learn to thank God for what he has created.

Unit Contents

Bible Truth

God made day and night. (Genesis 1:5)

Lesson 1 Day and Night

The children will learn that God created day and night. Through different activities they will understand the difference between day and night, and the difference between light and dark.

Lesson 2 Clouds and Sky

The children will learn that God made the sky and the clouds. They will also learn that God controls the weather.

Lesson 3 Sun, Moon and Stars

This lesson will help the children understand that God created the sun, moon and stars. The children will associate the sun with daytime and the moon and stars with nighttime.

Lesson 4 Review

This lesson reviews all the concepts presented in the previous lessons of this unit.

- Point out the sun to your child early in the morning, or at sunset, when it is most visible. Help your child to notice the clouds in the sky. Discuss that God made clouds and that clouds float in the sky. •
- Using cotton balls, make simple and recognizable cloud shapes together. Discuss how clouds in the sky have different shapes.
