U1 L1 Core

For each child:

- glue stick
- markers or crayons
- 2 paper plates
- 6 pieces of yarn, 8" long

For the teacher:

- magazines
- 3 pieces of poster board or banner paper
- scissors
- Bible
- felt board with black background
- black and white felt
- tape
- stapler
- construction paper
- markers and crayons
- glue stick

U1 L1 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 piece white paper
- crayons or markers
- glue stick
- decorative materials: cotton balls, twigs, leaves, yarn, etc.
- 1 Styrofoam ball, 3" diameter
- white glue
- clear tape

For the teacher:

- glue stick
- 24 index cards, 3" x 5"
- construction paper
- scissors
- laminate or clear contact paper (optional)
- pipe cleaners, 1/2 for each child
- poster board
- 1 sheet of white, green and blue tissue paper
- markers and crayons

U1 L2 Core

For each child:

- glue stick
- crayons
- 1 piece of card stock
- 1 piece of aluminum foil, 5"
- 1 piece of heavy yarn, 20"
- washable markers

For the teacher:

- roll of white banner or newsprint (at least 4' per child)
- water-based markers
- containers
- Bible
- socks or paper bags
- yarn or string
- cardboard
- glue stick
- scissors
- tape

- hole punch

U1 L2 Supplement

For each child:

- glue stick
- construction paper
- fabric scraps or felt scraps
- yarn, brown or black
- crayons, markers

For the teacher:

- newspapers or magazines such as Parenting, National Geographic and children's magazines
- 12 index cards, 3" x 5"
- pen
- poster board
- scissors
- cardboard
- glue stick

U1 L3 Core

For each child:

- large sheet of construction paper or butcher paper
- glue stick
- scissors
- 1 paper towel roll
- crayons and washable markers
- 1 piece green construction paper
- 1 piece white paper
- 2 pipe cleaners
- tape

For the teacher:

- magazines
- scissors
- Bible
- 2 sheets of construction paper: 1 white, 1 black
- clear tape
- pencil
- hole punch
- 4 toothpicks
- marker
- utility knife
- empty toilet paper roll
- glue sticks
- cotton balls
- Velcro fabric
- 2 old socks
- small ball
- cardboard

U1 L3 Supplement

For each child:

- glue stick
- crayons and markers
- yarn, 18" length

For the teacher:

- 1 large sheet of newsprint
- decorative materials: cotton balls, yarn, felt pieces, cloth pieces, dry macaroni, beads, craft sticks, etc.
- containers to hold materials

- stars or stickers
- 11 index cards
- 1 piece of construction paper
- light-colored poster board
- hole punch
- pencil
- clear contact paper
- marker
- scissors
- small ball
- 1 piece cardboard, 8 1/2" x 11" for every 9 children
- glue

U1 L4 Core

For each child:

- 9" x 6" piece of felt or construction paper
- 5 pieces of white construction paper, 6" x 4"
- crayons
- glue stick
- 1 piece of curling ribbon, 15"

For the teacher:

- construction paper
- colored paper
- glue stick
- scissors
- marker or pencil
- Bible
- shoe box
- magazines or calendars
- tape
- hole punch

U1 L4 Supplement

For each child:

- plastic or paper cup
- markers and crayons
- glue stick or tape
- newspaper
- spoon
- For the teacher:*
- construction paper
- colored paper
- scissors
- 1 bag of dirt
- 1 small packet of grass seeds
- water
- a small container for water
- shoe box
- magazines or calendars
- tape
- marker or pen

U2 L1 Core

For each child:

- 1 paper plate
- colored yarn
- 2 pieces of string or yarn, 12" long
- decorative materials: markers, crayons, stickers, feathers, etc.
- glue stick

For the teacher:

- card stock 8 1/2" x 40" (You may have to tape a few pieces together to make it long enough.)
- crayons
- marker
- 3 paper plates
- 3 craft sticks
- white glue
- 1 sock
- 1 piece of red felt, 1" x 2"
- decorative materials (optional)
- hole punch
- scissors

U2 L1 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 piece of oak tag or construction paper
- magazine pictures of gardens and 1 picture of a man and a woman
- craft sticks
- glue stick
- envelopes
- 3 index cards or thick paper
- magazine pictures of good and bad actions, such as: a clean room, a made bed, toys picked up, children fighting, a messy room, etc.
- a small paper bag
- 2 paper or Styrofoam cups
- 1 piece of kite string or yarn, 36" length
- decorative materials: crayons, construction paper, stickers, etc.

For the teacher:

- scissors
- stickers (optional)
- 2 bars of inexpensive soap
- masking tape
- construction paper
- 3 paper plates
- marker
- 3 craft sticks
- glue
- decorative materials (optional)

U2 L2 Core

For each child:

- glue stick
- shoe box or other small box
- scissors
- tape
- markers and crayons
- empty paper towel roll
- decorative items: scraps of construction paper, fabric, stickers

For the teacher:

- 1 large, refrigerator-sized box
- clear packing tape
- brown paper bags
- Bible
- felt board
- crayons
- tape
- permanent markers
- pen and paper
- scissors

- plastic bag for the puzzle pieces
- poster board or light cardboard
- white paper

U2 L2 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 brown paper lunch bag
- 1 set of contrasting objects (for example: 1 small rubber ball with many cotton balls, or 1 pen with many pencils, or 1 rock with many sticks. You may choose any other contrasting objects you can think of.)
- poster board
- decorative materials: stickers, ribbons, crayons, etc.
- markers
- brightly colored construction paper
- glue stick

For the teacher:

- 24 index cards (3" x 5") for every 4 children
- scissors
- laminate or clear contact paper (optional)
- stapler
- tape
- permanent markers
- pen and paper
- plastic bag for the puzzle pieces

U2 L3 Core

For each child:

- 1 large paper grocery bag
- crayons and markers
- construction paper
- decorative items for each animal: cotton balls, yarn, faux fur, etc.
- glue stick
- tape
- large envelopes, bags or folders

For the teacher:

- scissors
- masking tape
- 1 large white piece of paper
- crayons or markers (colors of the rainbow: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo and violet)
- colored construction paper
- glue stick
- magazines
- pen

U2 L3 Supplement

For each child:

- a new pencil (never sharpened)
- rainbow-colored crayons, or markers: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo and violet
- glue stick
- tape
- 1 paper plate, 9"
- 1 sheet of blue construction paper
- crayons

For the teacher:

- scissors
- pictures of animals
- hat or bag

- poster board
- stapler
- 2 large white pieces of paper
- crayons and markers (colors of the rainbow: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, violet)
- colored construction paper
- glue stick
- magazines

U2 L4 Core

For each child:

- 1 white paper plate, 6"
- brass fastener
- stickers for decoration
- markers, crayons and colored pencils
- glue stick
- tape

For the teacher:

- 2 large sheets of poster board
- tape
- scissors
- sandpaper
- small piece of cloth
- a bathrobe
- a scarf or piece of cloth for the blindfold
- ruler
- markers and crayons
- pencil
- hole punch

U2 L4 Supplement

For each child:

- marker
- glue
- crayons
- robe or sheet
- scarf or small hand towel
- 2 pieces of cardboard, 3" x 5"
- 1 circular piece cardboard, 3"
- 2 pieces black construction paper, 3" x 5"
- 2 pieces of black yarn, 16" and 9" lengths
- stickers
- 2 white narrow self-stick labels
- glue stick

For the teacher:

- 1 piece of construction paper for every 4 children
- 1 piece white paper, 8 1/2" x 11" for every 5 children
- poster board
- string
- hole punch
- scissors
- a scarf or piece of cloth

U2 L5 Core

For each child:

- craft stick
- glue stick
- tape
- 2 pieces of light-colored construction paper
- crayons or markers

- sticker, stamp, or ink stamps to represent the stamps on a passport

For the teacher:

- scissors
- 3 cotton balls per sheep
- 6 pieces of 2" long yarn: black, brown, white per goat
- 1 piece of cardboard, approximately 22" x 16"
- markers or crayons
- glue stick
- Popsicle sticks
- a box
- miscellaneous items such as a Bible, toy, pencil, stickers, etc.
- pictures of people: mothers, fathers, children, etc. (optional)
- a bag (optional)
- stapler

U2 L5 Supplement

For each child:

- envelope
- glue stick
- scissors
- markers
- 1 stick or dowel
- fabric glue

For the teacher:

- magazines
- scissors
- glue stick
- construction paper
- white cloth or material
- yarn
- assorted material scraps
- ruler
- a box
- miscellaneous items such as a Bible, toy, pencil, stickers, etc.
- pictures of people: mothers, fathers, children, etc. (optional)
- a bag (optional)

U2 L6 Core

For each child:

- 1 piece oak tag or white construction paper
- yellow and orange crayons
- glue stick
- glitter
- felt or tape
- small cup
- plastic spoon
- construction paper, including black and yellow
- silver Christmas tree tinsel
- clear tape

For the teacher:

- scissors
- felt board
- food or house magazines
- tape
- marker
- instant pudding mix
- milk
- mixing bowl
- mixing spoon

- measuring cup
- plain cookies or crackers or fruit for an optional snack
- apron
- pencil

U2 L6 Supplement

For each child:

- round doilies, 7"
- curling ribbon, 25" length
- glue stick

For the teacher:

- 20 index cards, 3" x 5" every 4 children
- scissors
- laminate or clear contact paper (optional)
- glue stick
- 1 piece of poster board or heavy cardboard, 36" square
- handkerchief or cloth for a blindfold
- tape
- stickers or some other reward (optional)
- hole punch
- colored paper
- small paper bag for confetti
- 1 block of mild cheese
- 1 box of crackers
- 1 plastic bag
- knife
- paper plates

U2 L7 Core

For each child:

- 4 craft sticks
- 5 cotton balls
- crayons
- 6 strands of yarn in various colors, 12" lengths
- construction paper - brown, green and blue
- envelope

For the teacher:

- 6 index cards, 3" x 5"
- 6 large sheets of drawing paper, 12" x 18" (use 24" x 36" paper for larger classes)
- 6 sets of crayons
- masking tape
- 5 pieces of white paper, 8 1/2 x 11"
- marker
- Bible
- tape
- 1 plate
- an assortment of cookies including: plain cookies and special cookies (chocolate or cream-filled)
- napkins
- light-colored construction paper
- scissors
- hole punch
- glue

U2 L7 Supplement

For each child:

- 1 piece oak tag or cardboard 8 1/2" x 11"

- 1 envelope

For the teacher:

- Adam and Eve costumes and props: real or artificial flowers, real or artificial fruit, toy snake and stuffed animals
- Noah costume and props: artificial or a cotton-ball beard, robe, tools, small tree branch and a spray bottle for rain
- Abraham costume and props: artificial or a cotton-ball beard, walking stick or a cane, headband, robe, travel stick or a backpack, compass and a water jug
- Sarah costume and props: scarf, shawl, bracelets, gray wig or a white pillow case
- Lot costume and props: robe, hat, simple map
- paper bags
- 20 index cards (3" x 5") for every 4 children
- laminate or clear contact paper (optional)
- scissors
- glue

- large variety of fabric scraps
- large variety of colored paper scraps
