Unit Overview

Lesson 3 The Shepherd

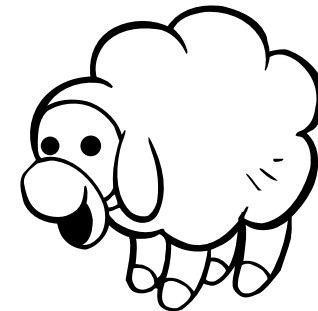
