U8 L5 Core

For each child:

- small rubber duckling that floats (you may use a foam or sponge duckling)
- large hollow plastic egg to hold rubber duckling
- 1 sheet of bright-colored construction paper (not green)
- 1 unlined index card, 5" x 7"
- glue stick
- brass paper fastener
- bright-colored tissue paper

For the teacher:

- Bible
- felt board
- 1 piece of tan felt, 8 1/2" x 11"
- 1 piece of white felt, 8 1/2" x 11"
- 1 piece of yellow felt, 8 1/2" x 11"
- 1 piece of brown felt, 2" x 2"
- scissors
- markers
- Easter basket to hold plastic eggs
- Easter grass
- 9" x 13" container to hold water
- water
- 1 egg carton
- 6 pairs of matching Easter stickers which depict "new life" (bunnies, chicks, flowers)
- 12 pairs of hollow plastic eggs (matched by color)
- paper bag
- 1 piece of yellow construction paper for chick
- green strip of construction paper
- black marker

U8 L5 Supplement

For each child:

- small rubber duckling that floats (you may use a foam or sponge duckling)
