Unit 8 at a Glance

God Made Me

Unit Overview

In this unit, the children will learn that God made people. They will study the creation of Adam and Eve and learn about the Garden of Eden. Additionally, the children will gain an understanding of their own uniqueness and how their bodies work. The unit also includes a special Easter lesson that focuses on "new life."

Unit Goals

- The children will identify Adam and Eve as the first man and woman ever created.
- The children will learn that God created everyone including themselves.
- The children will thank God for creating them.



Lesson 1 | Am Special

In this lesson, the children will learn about the first man and woman that God ever created, Adam and Eve. They will also learn about the Garden of Eden where Adam and Eve lived. The children will learn that God created each one of them and that he made them very special.

Lesson 2 | Am Blessed

God's creation of people will be studied further in this lesson. The children will learn to identify parts of their bodies, and will learn to thank God for giving them their bodies. The lesson also reinforces their knowledge of Adam, Eve and the Garden of Eden.

Lesson 3 I Have Senses

In this lesson, the children will study the five senses. They will name specific parts of their bodies, and will match these parts with the corresponding senses. The children will also identify ways that God makes them unique and special, such as hair color and eye color.

Lesson 4 God Made Everyone

This lesson reinforces that God created all people. The children will learn more about their bodies and how they function through activities that help stimulate their senses. They will thank God for creating them and giving them senses.

Lesson 5 God Gives New Life

This is a special Easter lesson that will help the children to understand "new life." Through the study of typical holiday-related items, such as eggs, chicks and bunnies, the unit concept of God creating life is reinforced.
