Moses

Unit Overview

A burning bush that does not burn up! The sea opening up, so God's people can walk through on dry land! This unit the children will be amazed by God's power and love, which are so vividly portrayed in the life of Moses. As Moses listened to God and followed God's plan for his life, so the children will be encouraged to listen to and obey the Bible, their parents and God's leaders.

Unit Goals

- The children will learn that Moses listened to God and obeyed him.
- The children will role-play following God's leaders.
- The children will thank God for taking care of his people.

Lesson 1 The Burning Bush

The children will learn that God spoke to Moses from the burning bush and that he told Moses to lead his people out of Egypt.

Lesson 2 Moses Listens to God

Moses listened to God, he took off his sandals when he was standing on holy ground, and he led the people out of Egypt. The children will learn that God wants them to listen to and obey him and their parents.

Lesson 3 The Red Sea

The children will role-play God's incredible miracles of love and protection as they follow Moses through the Red Sea. They will learn about God's cloud by day and his pillar of fire by night that directed the people which way to go.

Lesson 4 Moses Leads the People

The children will learn to imitate and follow God's leaders, just as the Israelites followed God's leader, Moses.

Your active involvement outside the classroom is essential and will truly make the Kingdom Kids Curriculum a great success for your child. Here are some suggested ways you can reinforce these lessons at home:

- Go for a "hike" with your child. Pack a picnic lunch, and go for a walk. Talk about the beautiful creation God has made for us to enjoy. Look for the small things to point out to your child—a ladybug, a butterfly, an interesting rock or leaf. Talk about how Moses had to walk a long way to lead God's people, but he did it because he loved God and wanted to obey him.
- Play with your child in a sandbox. Pretend it is the Red Sea. Open up a path for the people to walk through. Talk with your child about how God always loves us and takes care of us.
- Play a listening game with your child. Have your child close her eyes. Make a sound. Let your child guess what the sound is. Talk about how God gave us our ears so that we can listen.
