Missions

Unit Overview

Lesson 1 God Loves Paul

Scripture Memory Verse: Acts 9:20

At once he began to preach in the synagogues that Jesus is the Son of God.

God loves us and has vision for who we can become. Saul was a great example of this. Even though he was persecuting the Christians, God knew his heart and believed he could change. The children will talk about ways that God loves them. They will discuss ways that they can show God that they love him too.

Lesson 2 Ananias Loves Paul

Scripture Memory Verse: Acts 9:20

At once he began to preach in the synagogues that Jesus is the Son of God.

Ananias was afraid to go and help Saul but because he had talked to God about it he knew that he would be taken care of. The children will learn that they can pray to God when they are afraid and that he will take care of them.

Lesson 3 Thessalonica

Scripture Memory Verse: Acts 9:20

At once he began to preach in the synagogues that Jesus is the Son of God.

Paul and Silas were known as men who taught people about God. The children will share about why people need to have a relationship with God. They will also name people that they want to talk to about God.

Lesson 4 Berea

Scripture Memory Verse: Acts 17:11

The Bereans were of noble character, they examined the Scriptures every day.

The Bereans were people who were eager to know God. The children will talk about ways that they can be eager to know God too. They will pray to God to help them learn more about him.

Lesson 5 Athens

Scripture Memory Verse: Acts 17:11

The Bereans were of noble character, they examined the Scriptures every day.

Paul was a man who loved God and wanted to teach others about him. He wanted people to love God more than anything else. The children will learn that God wants us to love him more than anything else too. God works powerfully in our lives to help us have a relationship with him.

Lesson 6 Corinth

Scripture Memory Verse: Acts 17:11

The Bereans were of noble character, they examined the Scriptures every day.

Paul spent time living in Corinth and teaching people there about God. The children will learn that God protected Paul and that God protects them as well. They will list ways that they see God protecting them.

- Using blocks, make a city like Athens, Corinth or Berea. Pretend that you are Paul and Silas visiting that city and that you need to teach those people about God.
