### **Unit Overview**

Your active involvement outside the classroom is essential and will truly make the Kingdom Kids Curriculum a great success for your child. Here are some suggested ways you can reinforce these lessons at home:

- Join with several other families from your child's Bible class to host an end-of-the-year New Testament party. Design and send invitations made to look like parchment paper. Encourage everyone to come dressed as a New Testament character. Play New Testament review games such as charades or "Who Am I?" Have theme snacks and prizes. Invite your child's Bible class teachers and your friends who have visited church to come and join you.
- Help your child to lead a family devotional on the topic of "Jesus: Amazing and Powerful." Help them to find verses, songs and activities to make it special for the whole family. Take special time to honor and encourage your child for the ways they have grown this year.
- Talk to your child about the highlights of this year in Bible Class. Find out what they most enjoyed and in what areas they felt the least confident. Make a plan to help your child grow in the areas they need the most help and support. Encourage your child as they enter their new class in the Fall: If your child is going into 4th grade, they will begin an exciting survey of the Old Testament. If your child is going into the Preteen class, they will embark on an exciting theme-based series of classes and get a special Quiet Time notebook.
